## Join us in our Leap of Faith!

Ever since we took in the first White Eagle Boys in 1999 it's been our vision to provide them with so much more than just food, clothing and a bed. We've always wanted to provide them with a home: a space to eat, relax and have fun together. Currently the boys only have the church building in which to eat, relax and do their homework.

We completed the first phase of the boys' home – the first 6 bedrooms – in 2000 and now hope to begin phase 2 – a dining/living room and washrooms. This work will cost around £12,000 and God has been prompting us to move the boys into a more homely environment whilst we raise these funds.



The New Eagles' Nest!

We've decided to rent the upstairs of the building where the girls are living. The boys will have a dining room, living room, bedrooms and a bathroom with flushing toilet!

Of course this move takes funding, and we need to raise the money to pay the rent and buy basic furnishings.

We hope you are as excited as we are by this new development in the White Eagles' project. In total we need to raise £1,750 – below is a breakdown of some of our needs.
